Recreation Professions graduates work in diverse settings with diverse constituents. Recreation Services Management students find employment in municipal park and recreation departments, commercial recreation settings (e.g., resorts, sports and health clubs, and theme parks), state and federal agencies, armed forces, college campus departments, and non-profit organizations. Therapeutic Recreation students secure employment in pediatric hospitals, long-term care facilities, and transitional health-care facilities, treatment centers for individuals with emotional disturbances, chemical dependency programs, physical rehabilitation hospitals, community recreation programs, general medical hospitals, special camps, and schools. *For information about these and other careers, please go to www.onetonline.org/.*
