## Job Titles for Sociology Majors

Sociology programs provide information on theory, research methods, and conditions concerning the study of society, social institutions and social relationships. Most programs study how traditional, transitional and modern societies are organized. Also studied are interaction patterns of individuals, groups, and organizations. Emphasis on theory requires the ability to understand abstract material dealing not only with current social issues but also with fundamental processes of social organization and change. Sociology programs also require mastering a variety of research skills such as statistics, interviewing and participant observation. Sociology is a valuable preparation for careers in modern organizational settings. Although few occupations include sociologist in their title at the bachelor's level, sociology is excellent preparation for a wide variety of occupations. Students should look for entry-level positions, gain experience through internships, or watch for opportunities for specialized training or advanced education.
