**Description:** Key Responsibilities:

- \* Create a welcoming environment while serving as a facilitator during supervised parenting time at Karlis Family Center.
- \* Fulfill initial training and orientation process requirements.
- \* Complete initial training with the Parenting Time Program Director.
- \* Complete volunteer checklist and training hours.
- \* Complete Fatherhood Program specific projects, such as father-child activities and increasing knowledge of fatherhood resources.
- \* Initiate contact with 100% of the fathers in the Parenting Time Program and provide resources to those requesting resources and/or information.
- \* Assist with outreach activities to Denver Metro Child Support Enforcement Agencies.
- \* If possible, attend Colorado Dads monthly meetings.

- \* We ask each volunteer to attend the following trainings led by Family Tree experts: Volunteer Orientation, Domestic Violence Symposium, At-Risk Youth, Homelessness 101.
- \* Fatherhood Intern will have additional training from the Parenting Time Program Staff.
